

FLOWER SHOW RULES

- 1 Exhibitors must be Club Members.
- 2 Where applicable, Classes in the Schedule will be governed by the R.H.S. and N.A.F.A.S. Rules for Judging and W.I. "On with the Show" guidelines.
- 3 An Exhibitor may only make one entry in each Class.
- 4 No two persons from the same address may compete in the same Classes except in Home Produce, Floral Arrangements and Photography.
- 5 Plants in Pots must have been in Exhibitor's possession for at least three months.
- 6 An Exhibitor competing with an article that is proven not to be produced by him/her (except where otherwise stated), shall forfeit all prizes that may have been gained from that entry. Adults may offer advice in the Junior Sections.
- 7 Exhibitors must provide their own vases and dishes.
- 8 Nine inches diameter is the maximum size allowed for pots except in the Enterprise, Cactus, and Succulent Classes and where specified.
- 9 All pots must be stood on saucers.
- 10 Entry Forms must be returned to the Membership Secretary by the date and time given in the Schedule.
- 11 Entries must be staged during the time given in the Schedule.
- 12 No Exhibitor shall attach any personal identification mark to his/her Exhibit and Show Cards must be placed face down in front of the Exhibit.
- 13 After the time for completion of staging no Exhibit may be altered or removed until after the prize giving.
- 14 Once an Exhibit has been staged, it may only be moved by a Steward.
- 15 Entries judged not strictly according to Schedule will be disqualified.
- 16 The decision of the Judges shall be final as regards the relative merits of Exhibits.
- 17 The decision of the Committee shall be final on all questions in connection with the competition other than the relative merits of Exhibits.
- 18 The completion of the Entry Form shall imply acceptance of these conditions.
- 19 Any objection or protest should be submitted in writing before 4pm on the day of the Show to the Chairman, or in his/her absence, a member of the Committee.
